# Rosh Hashana

What is Rosh Hashanah and when do we celebrate it?



*Rosh Hashanah* means 'Head of the Year' in Hebrew. It is the beginning of ten days when Jewish people think very carefully about their behaviour during the past year.

We remember what we have done, ask and pray to be forgiven for any bad deeds and promise to be better next year.

Rosh Hashanah falls on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> days of Tishrei, which is the first Hebrew month. It lasts for two days.
